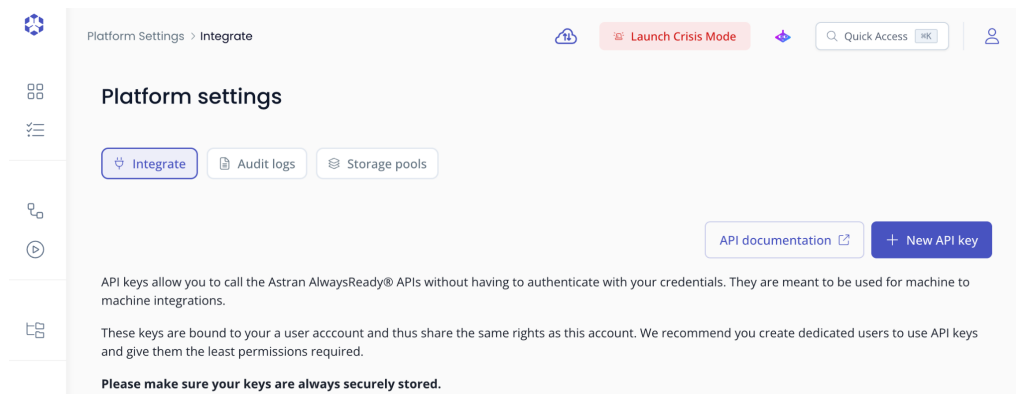

General UX

- Full revamp of the platform
- A banner will now prompt users to reload when a new platform version is available

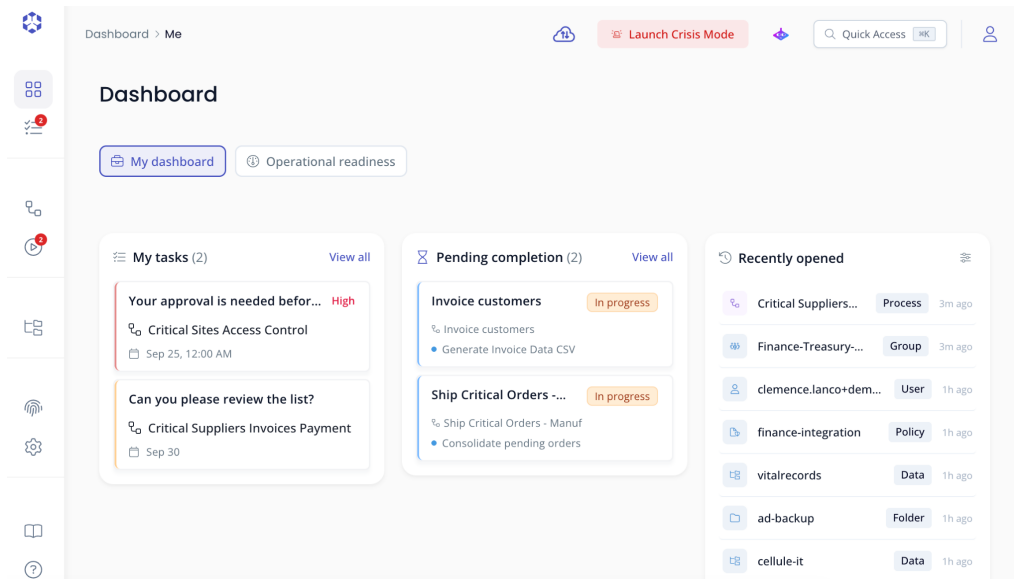
Relocated Features

- Steps of executions pending completions are now in a tab under 'Executions'
 - They were previously under 'Continuity Kits'
- “API documentation” is now accessible from Platform settings → Integrate

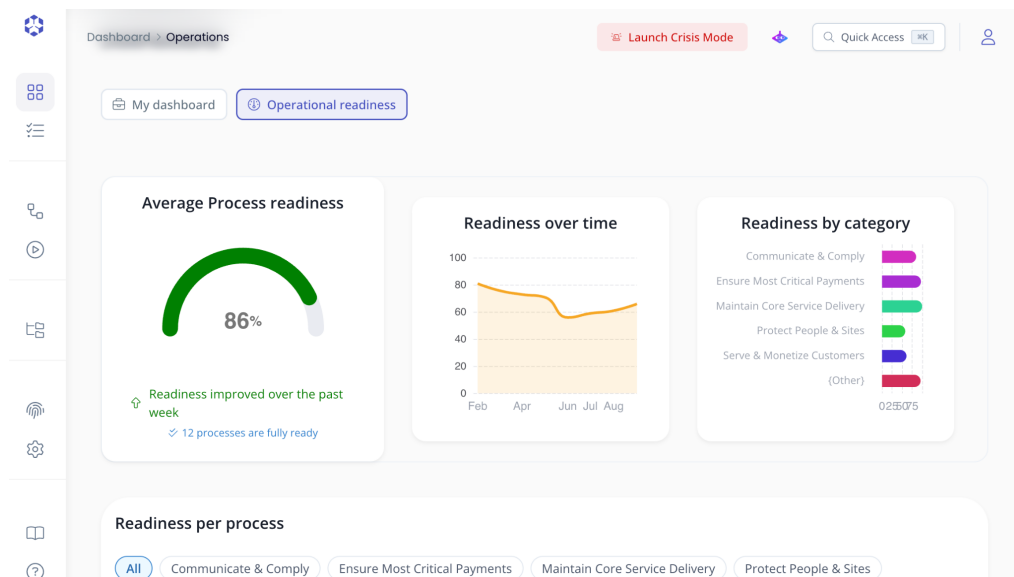


Dashboard

- New personal "My dashboard" showing assigned tasks, executions in progress, and recently accessed resources

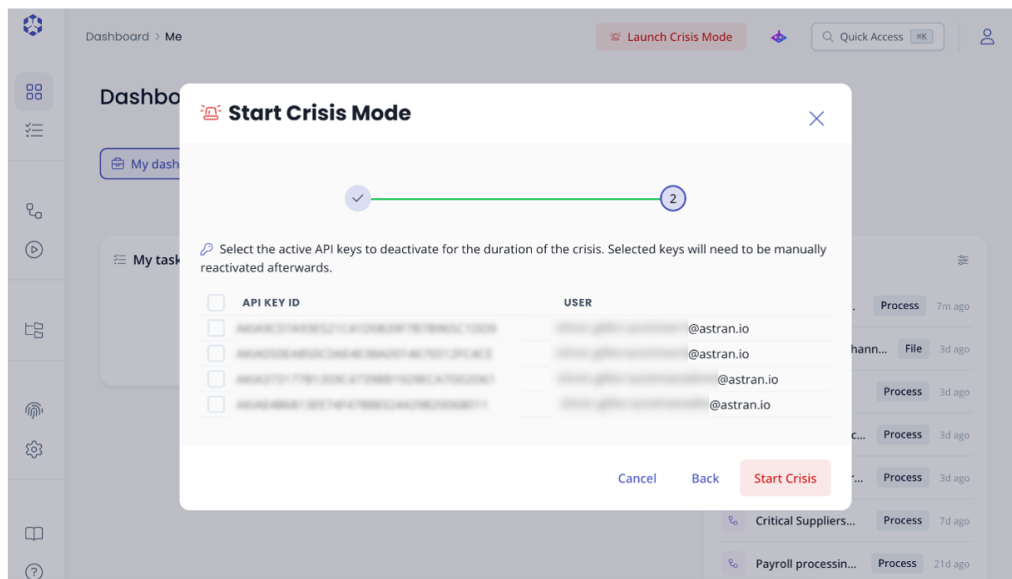


- “Operational readiness” view redesigned



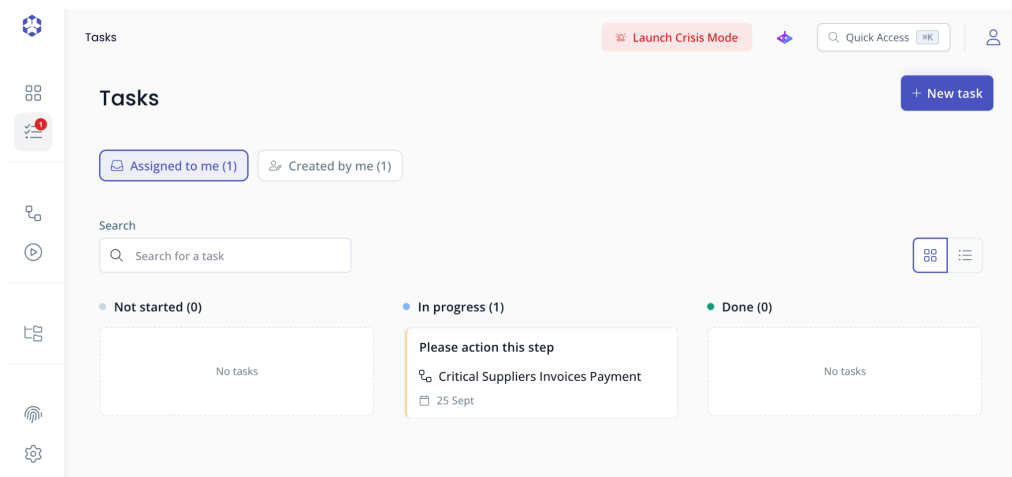
Crisis Mode

- Crisis Mode modal was redesigned
- API keys can now be deactivated the moment crisis mode is triggered



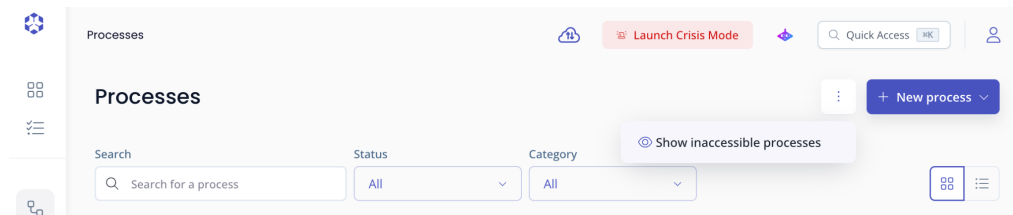
Tasks & Comments

- Tasks and comments were redesigned
- Tasks can be created directly from the Tasks page
- Tasks can be dragged and dropped to update their statuses

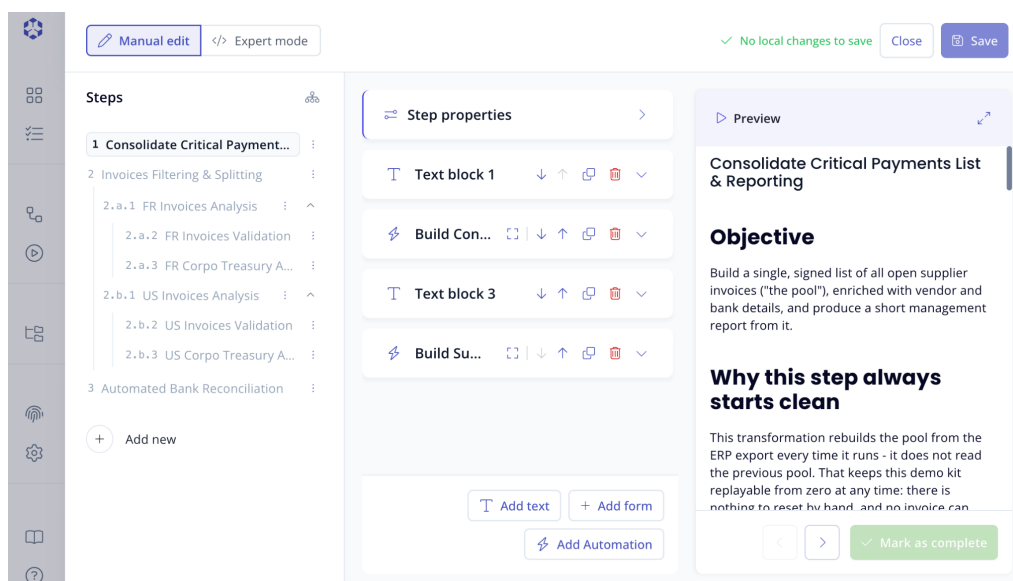


Processes → Editor

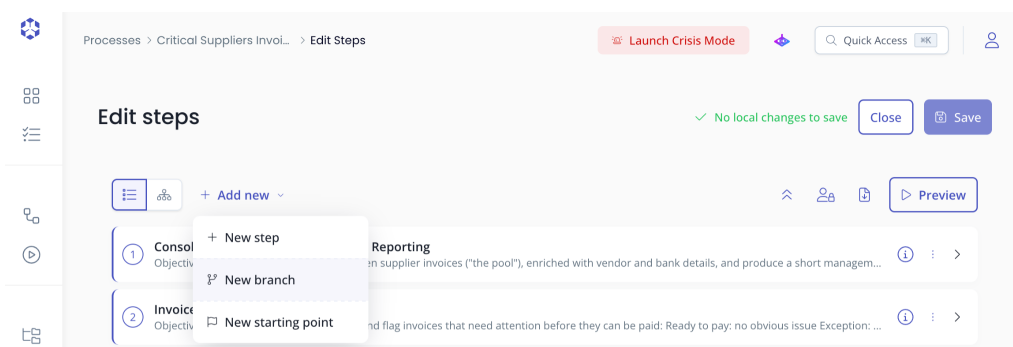
- Inaccessible processes can now be shown/hidden from the list

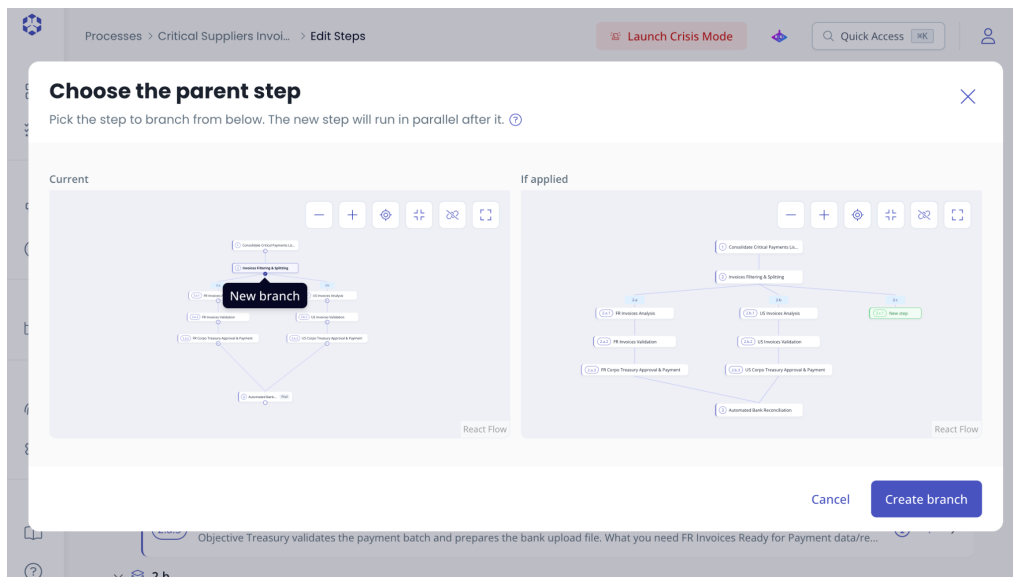
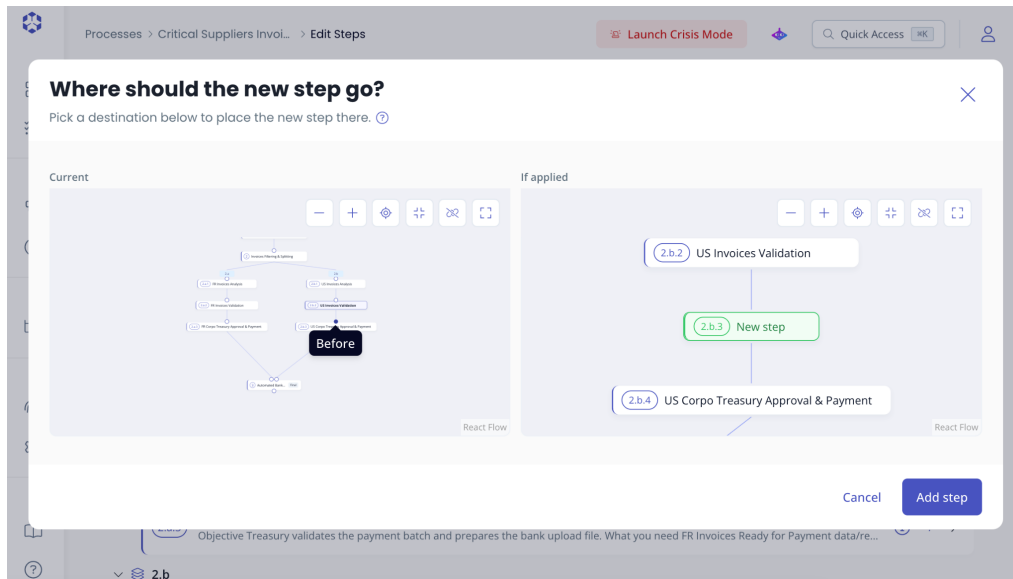


- Process edition has been entirely reviewed

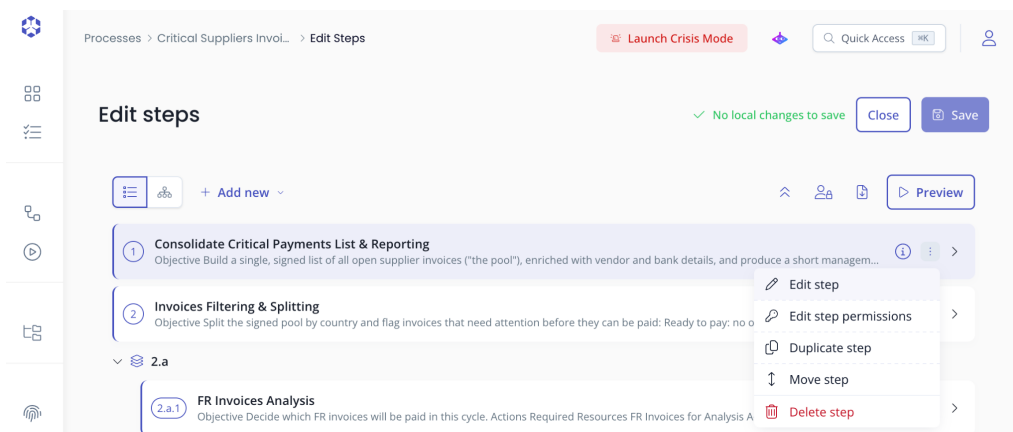


- You can now insert branches, steps, and starting points; you no longer need to rely on implicit dependencies and parallel flags

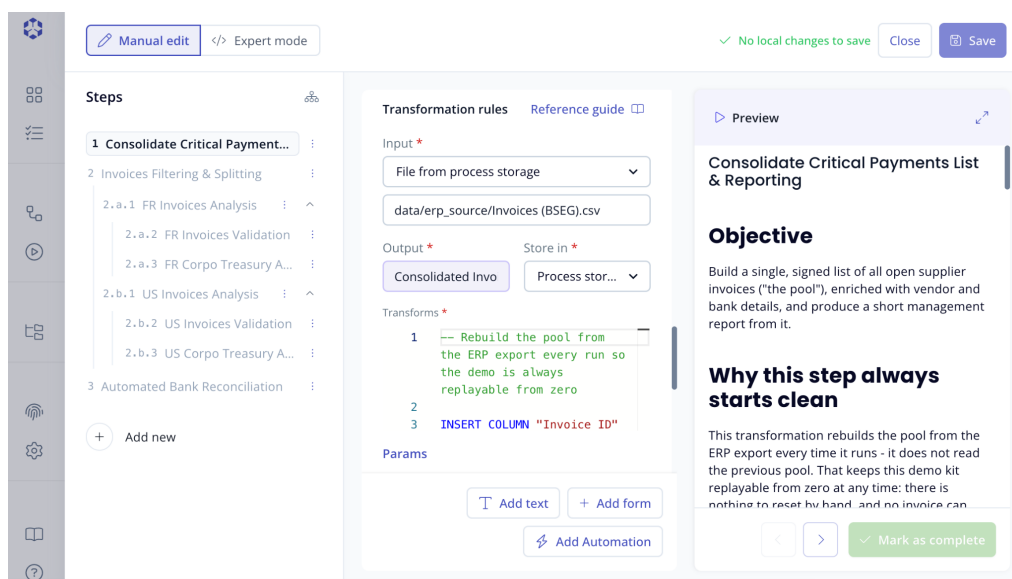




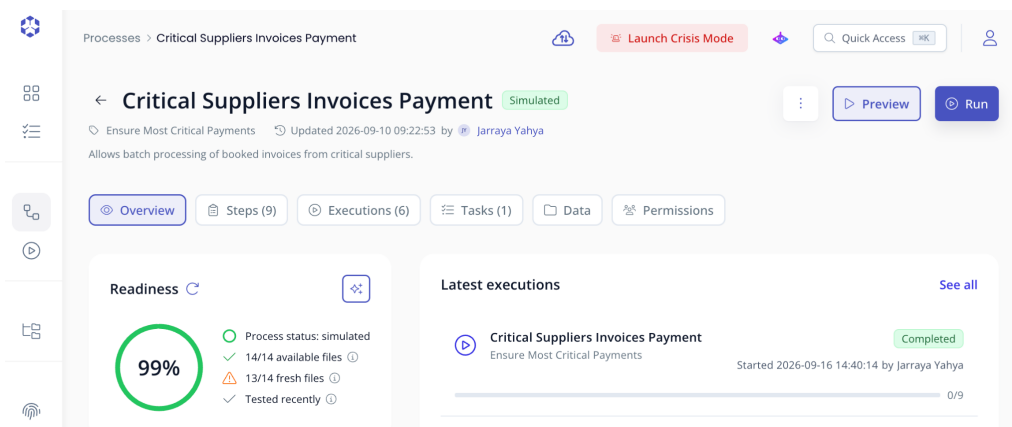
- You can individually edit a step, its permissions, duplicate it, move it or delete it



- Data transformation
 - Transformation instructions now live behind a "Reference guide" button
 - "Manual input" is now "Data from process": navigate and select files instead of free text
 - Output names for transformations are auto-generated, but can be overridden
 - Files under 200MB are auto-resolved by the editor: on CSV, the file is downloaded to inspect its columns, which are then suggested via autocomplete in transformation definitions

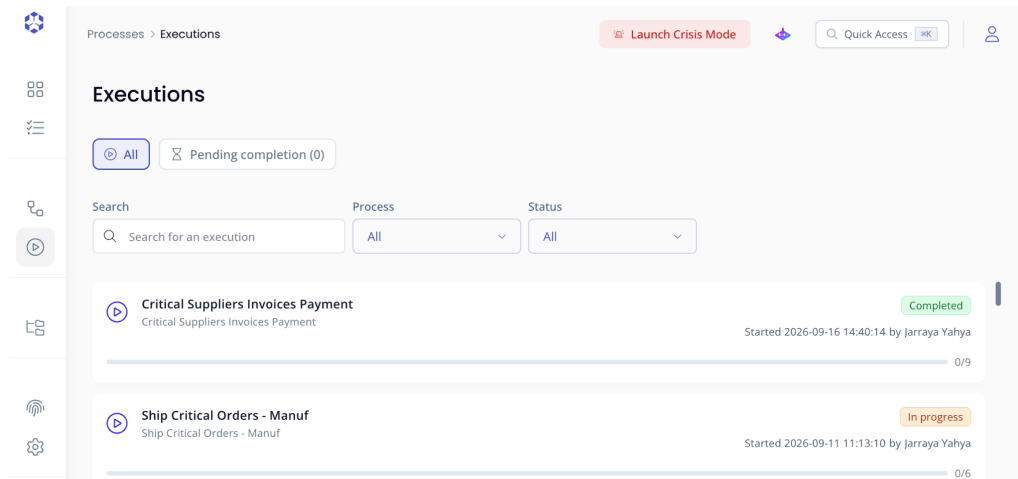


- Missing users or groups in permissions are highlighted in red
- Processes can be previewed from the 'Preview' button

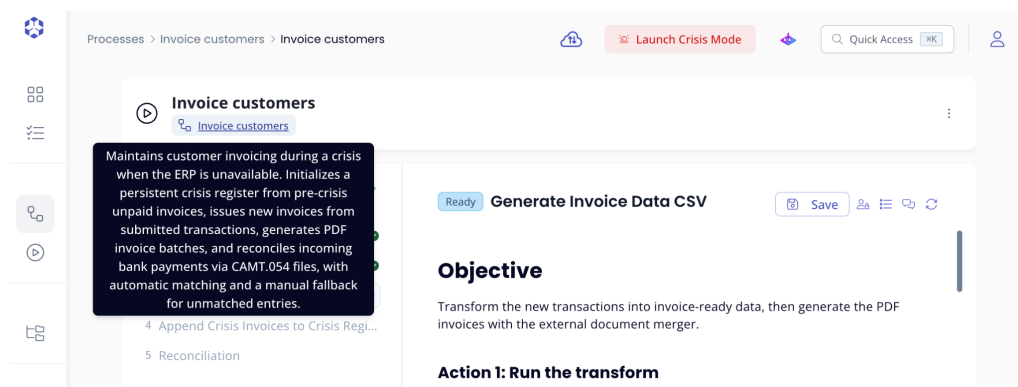


Processes → Execution

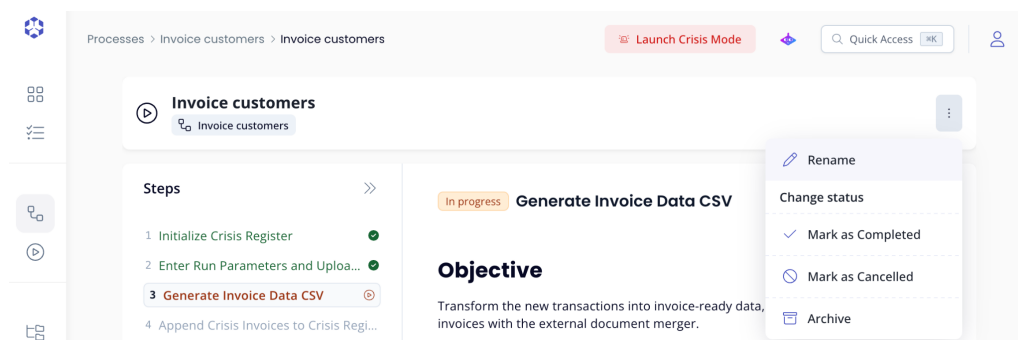
- New “Executions” view



- Process description is now a hover tooltip instead of always being shown

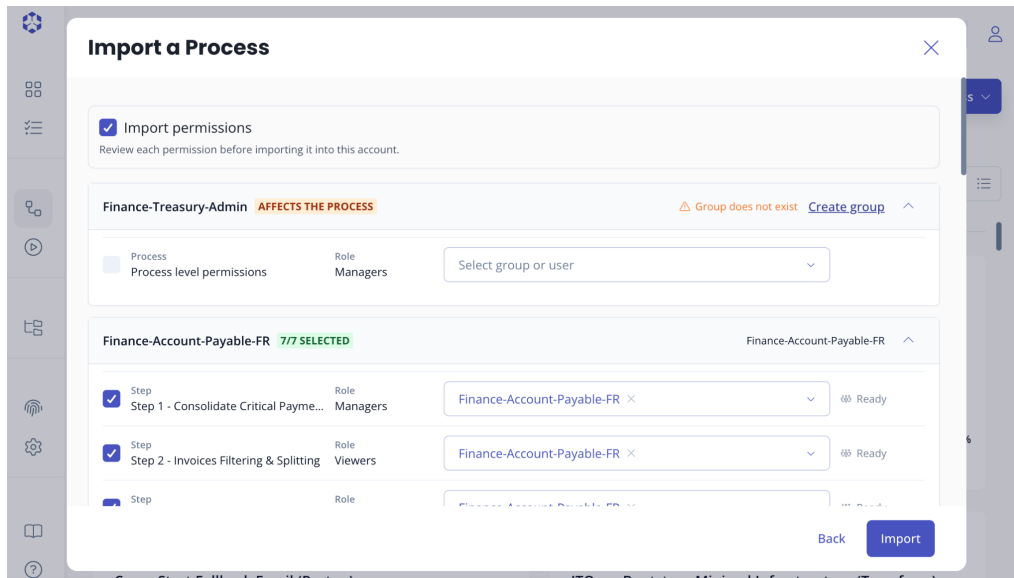


- Executions status can be manually updated
- Executions can be renamed



Import/Export of Processes

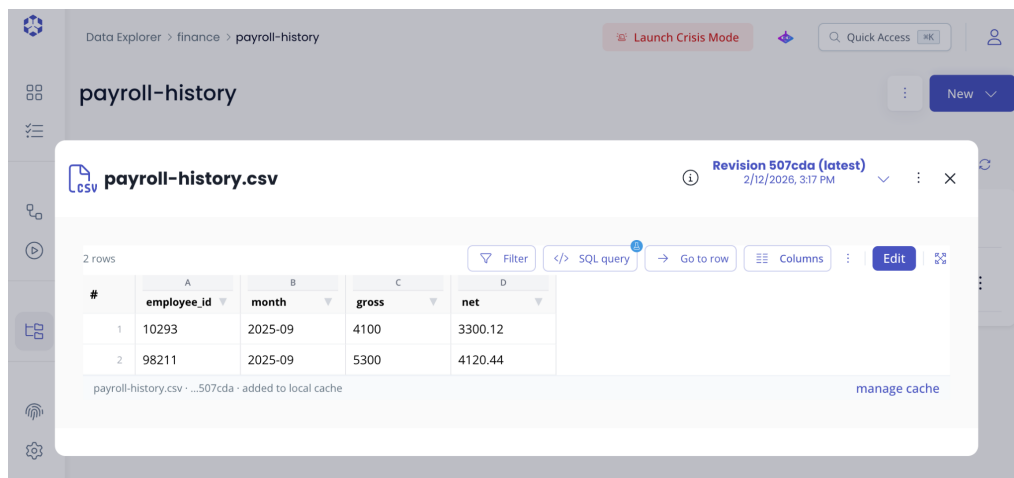
- Process import has been reviewed and allow you to manage process & steps level permissions
- Importing a process with missing groups or users allow you to recreate them along with the process for an easier import/export between environments



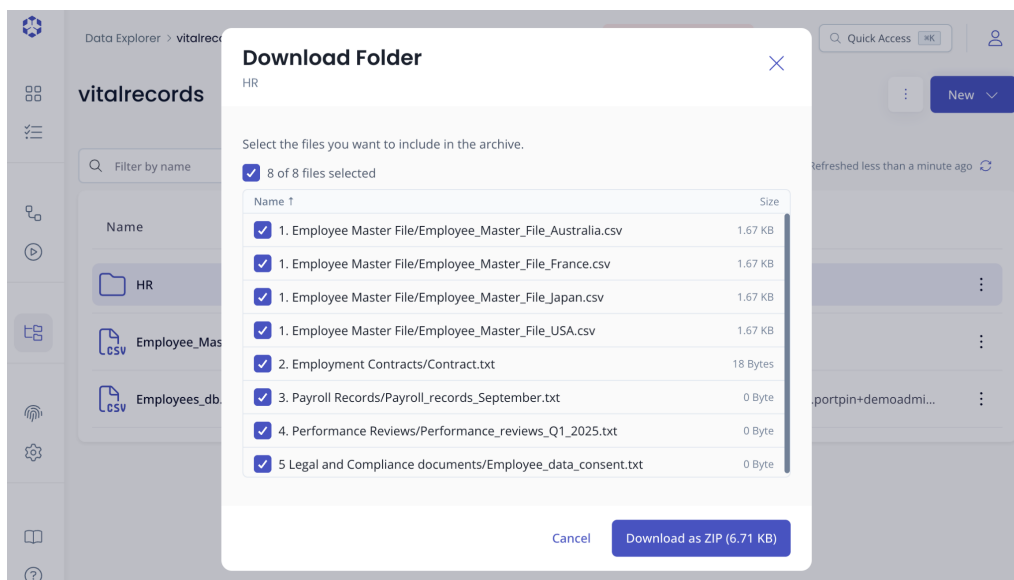
Data Explorer

- CSVs can be viewed regardless of size - limited only by the user's own machine
 - N.B.:** since the opening of CSV files is done on your computer, performances will vary according to your hardware specifications, and amount of opened tabs on your browser.
- User friendly filtering, with downloadable or saveable results
- Filters
 - Persist in the URL across refreshes, and are saved as local filter
 - Can be copied/pasted for reuse (e.g. in a process step description)
- Sorting works across multiple columns
- Loaded CSVs are cached locally for 7 days, with manual clearing available
- CSVs files under 300MB can be edited directly in Astran

- CSVs with a signature in the last row (.__SIGNATURE__/.__ROOT__ cells) cannot be edited, ensuring full/partial lines & columns remain unchanged

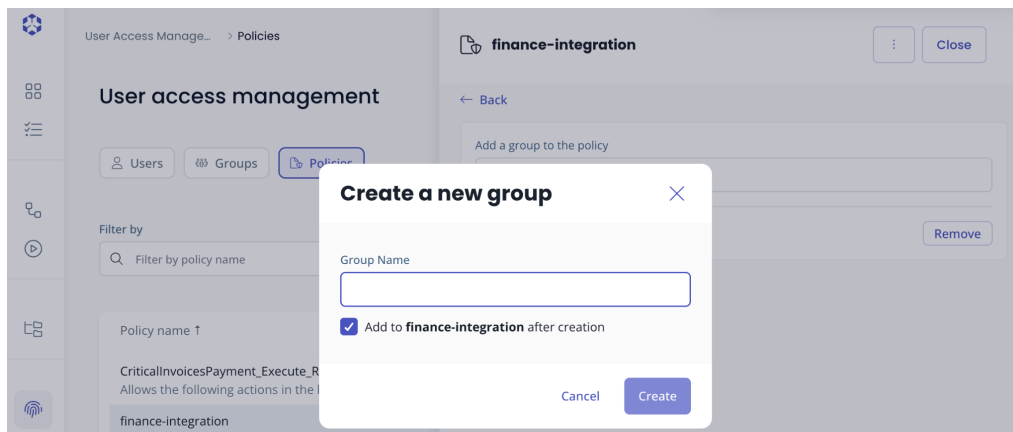


- File previews now show syntax coloring for XML, JSON
- Document previews stay open until explicitly closed or *Escape* is pressed
- Downloading a specific revision includes the revision ID in the filename; from the versions drawer panel
- Buckets or folders can be downloaded as a .zip, with a prompt to pick which files you need (including nested folders)



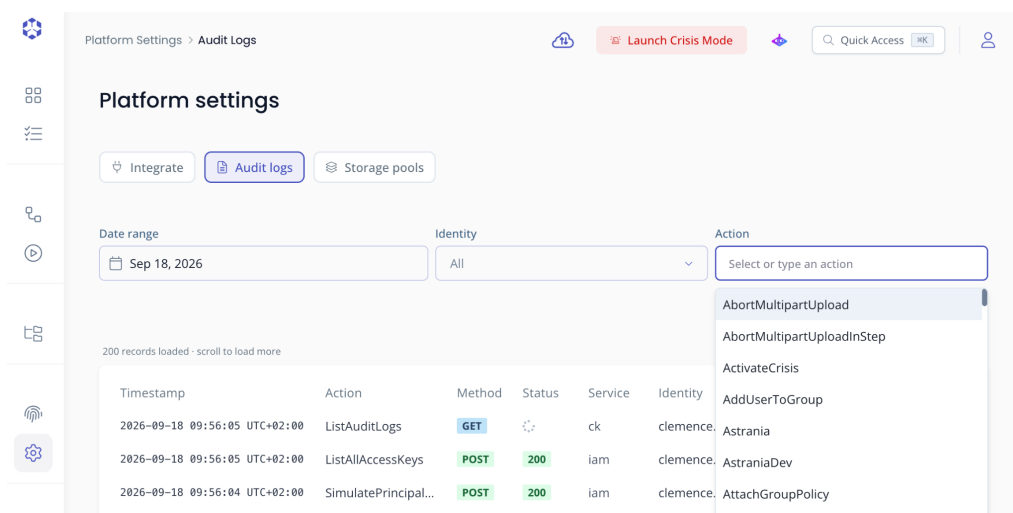
User Access Management (UAM)

- Lists of users, groups, and policies now show a clear 403 message if you do not have access to it
- Users, policies, and groups can now be sorted
- Password status shows up in both the listing and the user's drawer
- Addition of a credential status loader
- It is now possible to create a policy from a group's drawer, and a group from a policy's drawer
- Creating a group from a policy's details panel will pre-fill the creation modal; a checkbox to auto-attach the policy to the new group will appear



Audit Log

- Actions can be picked from a dropdown



[NEW] User Events

- Admins can now view login and account activity (successful/failed logins, logouts, password changes, MFA/passkey setup or removal, reset requests) from the UAM User tab, per user or across all users
- Token refresh and SSO identity linking events are also available
